



**Common Good Initiative Investments – Lincoln Park

Through Allegany Franciscan Ministries, the Lincoln Park Council for the Common Good has invested more than \$5.7 million to support community-identified priorities and community activities in Lincoln Park. In the current fiscal year (beginning July 2020), \$1,580,635 has been invested.
