



**Common Good Initiative Investments – Lincoln Park
As of April 30, 2022**

Through Allegany Franciscan Ministries, the Lincoln Park Council for the Common Good has invested more than \$6.5 million to support community-identified priorities and community activities in Lincoln Park.
